Dear COUNCILLOR OR MAYOR (as appropriate),

As a resident of Ward **[Insert Ward Number]** and a proud Calgarian, I am writing to you today regarding the upcoming provincial vote on October 19th, 2026. As you are aware, Premier Danielle Smith has introduced a tenth ballot question asking Albertans if the provincial government should commence the legal process to hold a binding referendum on separating from Canada.

The Alberta Prosperity Project and the provincial politicians enabling them have argued that a sub-region of a country has the unilateral right to decouple itself from a larger federation to protect its economic interests. If this logic holds true for the province, it must hold true for our city. If the province votes to trigger a separation process, Calgary's economic stability will be placed at immediate risk.

Therefore, I am formally asking you to table a motion directing Calgary City Council to commence the legal process required to hold a municipal referendum. This ballot should ask a simple YES/NO question:

**If the Government of Alberta commences the legal process required under the Canadian Constitution to hold a binding provincial referendum on whether or not Alberta should separate from Canada, should Calgary City Council commence the legal process required under the Canadian Constitution to hold a binding municipal referendum on whether or not Calgary should remain part of Canada if the rest of Alberta chooses to separate?**

Calgary City Council has a fiduciary duty to protect its citizens by offering us the same mechanism of self-determination. We cannot allow an unstable, fringe movement to drag our city out of Canada without our explicit, municipal consent.

I look forward to hearing your position on securing Calgary's place in the Canadian federation within a separated Alberta.
